## **Federal Funding**

The White House has indicated support for a \$299 billion 6-year bill – up from \$256 originally requested. Conferees are meeting.

## **SPLOST**

Gwinnett County and the Cities have reached a SPLOST agreement and the call for a November referendum is likely this week. The County estimates transportation projects of \$180 million over 5 years – less than the previous allocation. Our Board has requested some \$16 million in corridor improvements.

## **Inter-Parcel Access**

Discussions ongoing with Little/Westside; Cambridge; Paxton Lane; and Restaurant Row inter-parcel projects. Restaurant Row IPA meeting on Thursday, August 26 at 4pm at A&J BBQ.
