Corridor Landscape

We have had DOT landscapers here for several weeks, making their corrections. They are ready to release the project and Evermore can officially take over all the medians. This may also be a good time to consider sweeping the corridor again.

West Park Place Interchange

Signs are complete and the DOT is ready to install. We need to set a date and time for a formal ceremony. Additionally, if we are considering improving the interchange and bridges, now is the time of year to do so.

Hewatt/Parkwood/Britt

A Public Hearing Open House (PHOH) was held June 30th, and was well attended. A follow up meeting was also held with residential stakeholders.

General Information
